*All skulls must be maggot free! Maggots pose a huge threat to beetle colonies. Any skulls with maggots will be charged a \$100 removal charge. All skulls & heads should be frozen for a minimum of 3 days prior to dropping off at our facility. Any heads not frozen for the minimum time will be charged a \$25 Freezing fee. All Skulls will be processed according to our standard practices methodology. By signing this form, you agree to have the skull listed below processed according to our standard practices and release Bare Bones Taxidermy from liability beyond the cost of services as long as the standard practices are followed. ### Standard Practice Methodology:

1. All Skulls will be frozen for a minimum of 3 days unless they are frozen when they are received.
2. Skulls will be cleaned of all meat through the use of Dermestid Beetles. 3) Cleaned Skulls will be soaked in 100o-130o water with a degreasing solution for varying amounts of time depending on the animal and how long it takes for all grease to be removed. Final degreasing sometimes requires the use of solvents in addition to degreasing solution and water. Antlers will be wet during this process. Some color change may occur if the antlers are partially stained from tree rubbing, but the true antler color is not affected by the soaking process.
3. After Degreasing, skulls will be whitened with a peroxide solution. If the skull has antlers or horns, they will be covered at the bases with liquid latex to prevent whitening. If whitening occurs, Antlers will be stained to their original color.
4. Once the skulls are whitened that are preserved with a Museum Grade bone preservative. This product will preserve interior and exterior bone structures and leave your trophy with a natural white bone look and feel.

### Pick up Policy

Once Bare Bones has notified you that your skull(s) are complete and ready for pick up, we allow two weeks for pick up, or for you to arrange for shipping/delivery. After the two week period, you will be charged a 25% storage fee. 45 days after we have notified you that your skull(s) are completed, if we have had not communication from you and arrangements for pick up or delivery, the skulls will become the property of Bare Bones. At that time we will begin the process of selling the skull mount. You may purchase your skull back from us at any time prior to its sale at the original cost for the mount plus 50% (less your original deposit). Please understand that this policy is necessary in order to insure we have prompt pick up of all skulls. If you have special circumstances, please advise and we will work with you.
